## Please note:

- 1. Semester The semester indicated is F (Fall September), W (Winter January) or I (Intersession May). This is the semester when the course is offered.
- 2. Registration Registration information for an upcoming semester is posted on the <a href="CNA ECE DL webpages">CNA ECE DL webpages</a> under STUDENTS/CURRENT/COURSE REGISTRATION/WHEN DO I REGISTER FOR COURSES.
- 3. Prior Learning Assessment and Recognition (PLAR) Learners who have prior experience in a particular area or topic may be eligible to apply for PLAR. Information on the reasons why a learner is applying must be provided on the PLAR application form. Applications for PLAR may be submitted when registering each term, or may be submitted as a Comprehensive PLAR (in the term the course is not offered). Deadline for PLAR applications are posted on the <a href="CNA ECE DL webpages">CNA ECE DL webpages</a> under STUDENTS/FUTURE/PRIOR LEARNING/CREDIT FOR PRIOR LEARNING.
- 4. As per College policy, the maximum number of credits that can be awarded through Exemption and/or PLAR is 75% of the number required to complete the certificate.

- 5. Prerequisites When registering for courses, please take note of the prerequisites. These are courses you must have completed before you can register for or PLAR that course.
- 6. Students in the ECE Online Certificate program are required to complete two Field Placements: FW1600 (5 weeks) and FW1601 (5 weeks). Provincial program standards require that learners must complete a majority of their placements in a regulated child care centre. A minimum of 260 hours for the Certificate, must be completed in a regulated child care centre, while the remaining hours may be in a regulated family child care home, child care centre, a family child care agency, a kindergarten classroom, or a family resource centre.

For those online students currently working in regulated child care, for less than 6 consecutive months from the start of FW1600, a minimum of 1 week must be completed at a College of the North Atlantic (CNA) demonstration child care centre. Written confirmation of work experience will be required. An additional week at a CNA demonstration child care centre (for a total of 2 weeks out of the required 10 weeks) will be mandatory for students not working in regulated child care.

Applicable students will be assigned a CNA demonstration child care centre based on geographical location. Our centres are located in St. John's, Corner Brook and Happy Valley - Goose Bay. Please note: Students will be informed of the dates and which field placement course (FW1600 or FW1601) the mandatory week(s) will be completed.

7. Prior to the start of a field placement, students must submit to Student Services, a current copy of at least an emergency level (one day) diploma/certificate in first aid and CPR dealing with children. A list of approved first aid training providers can be found on the Workplace NL website.
