Bachelor of Applied Arts: Early Childhood Education ***Comprehensive Prior Learning and Recognition (PLAR) Procedures***

- **NOTE: *Comprehensive PLAR*** applications occur when an applicant is not registered for the course they are looking to challenge. An ***In-Semester PLAR*** would be required for a student who is currently enrolled in the course to be challenged. Please contact the Instructional Coordinator for more information.
- Comprehensive PLAR assessments will be scheduled to take place during midterm or final exam period, and at the Instructional Coordinators discretion.
- Individuals applying for Comprehensive PLAR must be currently active in the Bachelor of Applied Arts: Early Childhood Education program.
- As a result of time and resources needed to assess Comprehensive PLAR requests, learners are strongly advised that their Comprehensive PLAR application be submitted to ecedl@cna.nl.ca, by the deadline listed on the website.
- Current learners will be permitted to submit Comprehensive PLAR applications for any courses in the program **(with the exception of EE4010, EE4030 and EE4045)** for which they believe they have already acquired the appropriate level of knowledge and skills.
