Bachelor of Applied Arts: Early Childhood Education Comprehensive Prior Learning and Recognition (PLAR) Procedures

- NOTE: Comprehensive PLAR applications occur when an applicant is not registered for the course they are looking to challenge. An *In-Semester PLAR* would be required for a student who is currently enrolled in the course to be challenged. Please contact the Instructional Coordinator for more information.
- Comprehensive PLAR assessments will be scheduled to take place during midterm or final exam period, and at the Instructional Coordinators discretion.
- Individuals applying for Comprehensive PLAR must be currently active in the Bachelor of Applied Arts: Early Childhood Education program.
- As a result of time and resources needed to assess Comprehensive PLAR requests, learners are strongly advised that their Comprehensive PLAR application be submitted to <u>ecedl@cna.nl.ca</u>, by the deadline listed on the website.
- Current learners will be permitted to submit Comprehensive PLAR applications for any courses in the program (with the exception of EE4010, EE4030 and EE4045) for which they believe they have already acquired the appropriate level of knowledge and skills.
